Sub: Allotment of Surplus Qualified OC candidates of Inspectors of Posts Examination for the year 2008 held on 5th, 6th & 7th November 2008 to fill up the unfilled OC vacancies of other Circles.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to this office letter of even number dated 18-09-2009 wherein the result of IP Examination 2008 was declared and subsequent letter dated 08-10-2009 addressed to few Circles covering supplementary result.

2. The issue relating to allotment of Surplus Qualified candidates is examined on the basis of fresh options received from the candidates to fill up the **surplus OC vacancies** available in other Circles. Accordingly, a list showing names of officials with roll numbers according to their order of merit, marks obtained by the candidates in each paper/total marks, options given by the candidates and name of the circle to which each candidate allotted according to order of preference is enclosed for necessary action by the Circles concerned. **Names of 5 candidates of SC category, who secured merit marks (40% in each paper and 45% aggregate of all five papers) and became eligible for consideration against OC vacancies without relaxed standards, were also included in the list.**

3. Consequent upon the decision of the Department, to allow the lady IPs working in other Circles without observing required minimum service as laid down under Rule 38 of Postal Manual Volume IV, vide letter No. A-34013/01/2009-DE/SPB II dated 5th February 2010, it is further decided to allot the lady surplus IP candidates of IP Examination 2008 in the Home Circle against the existing/future vacancies. As per the information given by the Circles, the position is as follows:

Andhra Pradesh	4 OC (likely to arise very soon due to promotion of IPs as ASP)
Delhi	No vacancy
Kerala	No vacancy
Orissa	2 OC (likely to arise very soon due to promotion of IPs as ASP)
Punjab	8 (likely to arise very soon due to promotion of IPs as ASP)
Tamil Nadu	21 (likely to arise very soon due to promotion of 21 IPs as ASPs)

Accordingly, lady candidate of **A.P., Orissa, Punjab and Tamil Nadu Circles** are allotted to the same Circle for **accommodating them in the existing/future vacancies**. Surplus lady candidates of **Delhi and Kerala Circles are allotted to the Circles as per their choice given in the option** as no vacancy is available and no vacancy is likely to arise in the near future in these two Circles.

4. **(a)** The seniority of the selected Inspectors of 2007, 2008 including Direct Recruit Inspectors and Surplus lady IPs of IP Examination 2008 will be considered as follows **for promotion to ASP grade as per the following order:**

- (i) IPs 2007, Surplus IPs and candidates selected under review for failed SC/ST candidates of the same year in the Circle;
- (ii) IPs 2008, Surplus IPs and candidates selected under review for failed SC/ST candidates of the same year in the Circle;
- (iii) Surplus IPs/DR IPs of 2007 transferred from other Circles under Rule 38 and Surplus IP male candidates 2008 who are ranked above the surplus lady candidates, if any, in the Surplus Merit List of 2008 irrespective of their date of joining in the Circle of their choice under Rule 38;
- (iv) Surplus lady IPs of 2008.

(b) For promotion to Postal Service Group 'B', the seniority of the above mentioned IPs would be reckoned as per the All-India Merit/Seniority List only maintained by Postal Directorate.


5. As per the scheme of Surplus Qualified IP candidates, Surplus vacancies under SC/ST category will be first filled up by review of cases of failed SC/ST candidates by the High Power Committee of the concerned Circle. Vacancies remain unfilled, if any, in the Circle will then be thrown open to the SC/ST candidates who were declared as Surplus Qualified under relaxed standards vide this office letter of even No. dated 18-09-2009. Heads of Circles are, therefore, requested to complete the review process of failed candidates at the earliest and convey the decision of the High Power Committee to Director (SPN) for further action. In this connection, this office letter even No dated 05-02-2010 addressed to the concerned Circles may be referred.

6. Training Division of Directorate is being requested to issue orders for arranging a special programme for conducting induction training to enable the officials to join their new Circle/place of allotment/posting.


